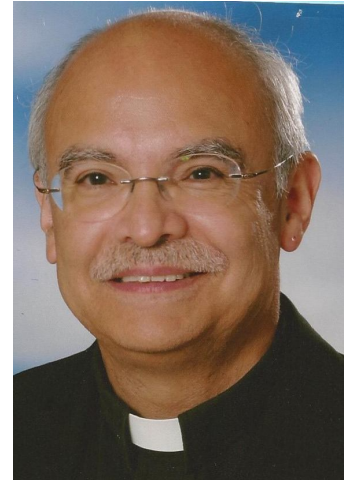

THE HOLY LAND: SAMPLE Itinerary

Draw closer to Jesus of Nazareth, as we follow in His footsteps. Each day of your pilgrimage you will have time to renew and affirm your faith; to pray and reflect. The Scriptures will come alive as you visit Our Lord's homeland. You will be inspired by the natural beauty of the landscape, in addition to its rich historical heritage. It is an encounter that has changed the lives of many pilgrims, an act of faith and prayer.

Day 1: Nov 11, Monday, Departure from Seattle

Board flight for your journey to Tel Aviv, with meals & beverages.

Day 2: Nov 12, Tuesday, Arrive Tel Aviv

On arrival in Tel Aviv you will be met, transferred to your hotel. **D**

Day 3: Nov 13, Wednesday, Caesarea, Nazareth, Cana

Theme: The Annunciation Depart for Caesarea, once the ancient capital of the Roman province. View the impressive archaeological remains of the Roman and Byzantine city. Here, Peter came to understand that the Good News was not for Jews only, but for the whole world. He baptized the Roman Centurion, Cornelius, & his family. It was from Caesarea that Paul set sail for Rome. Visit Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery with the Madonna of Mt Carmel. At Nazareth, see the site of Mary's home and the town where Jesus lived as a child. Later visit Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle at the request of His mother [John 2: 1-11]. **B & D**

Day 4: Nov 14, Thursday, Tiberias, Sea of Galilee

Theme: The Ministry Start at the Mount of Beatitudes, scene of the Sermon on the Mount. Drive to Capernaum, from where Jesus began his Ministry; see the synagogue which dates to the time of Jesus and the church built over the site of Peter's home. At Caesarea Philippi, see where Jesus told St. Peter —You are the Rock, and upon this rock I will build my Church. **B & D.**

Day 5: Nov 15, Friday, Jordan River — Mt. Tabor — Jericho

Theme: The Transfiguration Start today by remembering Baptism at the Jordan River. Drive to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Continue to Jericho to see the excavations of the oldest city in the world. View the Mt of Temptations on arrival in Jerusalem. **B & D**

Day 6: Nov 16, Saturday, Temple Model, Ein Karem, Bethlehem

Theme: The Visitation and Nativity See the Second Temple model as it was at the time of Jesus. Visit Ein Karem, birthplace of John Baptist.

Mission visits will be made to the Home of Peace and Holy Child Program Bethlehem, lunch included. At Bethlehem, enter the Church and go down to the Grotto of the Nativity, the place of Jesus' birth. **B & L & D**

Day 7: Nov 17, Sunday, Bethany, Masada, Qumran, Dead Sea

Theme: the Wilderness. Motor to the Jordan Valley to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. It's time for a dip in the Dead Sea. Visit to Masada, the last stronghold of Jewish resistance to the Romans. A stop in Bethany where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. **B & D**

Day 8: Nov 18, Monday, Jerusalem, Mt of Olives, Western Wall

Theme: Palm Sunday and the Agony in the Garden Take in the panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then at Pater Noster shrine, Jesus taught His disciples The Lord's Prayer (Luke 11:1-4)., then walkdown Palm Sunday Road. At Gethsemane reflect on Jesus' final night. At Mt. Zion visit the Upper Room, which commemorates the Last Supper. **B & D**

Day 9: Nov 19, Tue, Jerusalem, Val Dolorosa, Holy Sepulchre,

Theme: The Way of the Cross, The Crucifixion, The Resurrection Enter the Old City, visit the Western Wall, the Temple Area, stop at the Jewish Quarter and see the Cardo. See the Pool of Bethesda where the angel ruffled the water, and St. Anne's Church, traditional birthplace of Jesus' mother. Pass the Stations of the Cross to the Church of The Holy Sepulchre. Visit Home of Peace, Ascension Chapel. **B & L & D**

Day 10: Nov 20, Wed, Return to Seattle
